When Rochester Public Library heard that some members of the northwest community were having trouble getting to the library, an old solution was reborn using modern technology. A new hybrid model combines both traditional onsite and mobile library services provided by the current Lyell Branch staff.

The earliest mobile library, a horse-drawn book-wagon, began in 1904, displaying 200 books. 30 years later trucks and buses began their 80-year transportation of the Monroe County Traveling Library carrying 1,000 books. Today, RPL's van-size mobile library, RPL GO!, doesn't just have books. It has pop-up programming, portable Wi-Fi, and hardware for printing, scanning and faxing. This model is designed with inclusivity at its core, ensuring that people of all ages and backgrounds can benefit from library services—regardless of their location or circumstances.

With RPL GO! available, the opportunities to expand services grow daily! It travels to childcare centers and schools, senior living communities, organizations serving at-risk populations, parks, and community events.
